PAYMENT OF SUPPLEMENTS

- Supplements are paid by direct deposit on a monthly basis by Wake County SmartStart (WCSS)
- Supplement amounts are assessed regularly by Child Care Services Association
 - Monthly Assessments include review of the following data to ensure minimum eligibility requirements are being satisfied
 - 4-Star Minimum
 - No open Administrative Actions **or substantiated cases of child maltreatment**
 - At least 2 subsidy participants birth-5 for centers, 1 for Family Child Care Homes
 - Quarterly Assessments will include review of the following data points to re-set supplement rates, if funds are available
 - Star-Rating
 - Number of subsidy children being served
 - Program Standard Points
 - Accreditation
 - Active participation in approved quality-improvement activity, if applicable
