- TEACH will award a \$350 bonus to scholars upon completion of 12 credit hours. Scholars only completing 6 credit hours total will receive \$175.

As a T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® Working Scholar YOU are expected to:

- Enroll in and complete coursework leading towards an Associate or Bachelor's degree in early childhood education or child development
- Maintain acceptable academic standing with an overall GPA of 2.0 for Associate degree scholars or 2.5 for Bachelor's degree scholars
- Maintain at least 30 hours per week of employment in a North Carolina licensed facility
- Commit to work six months in a licensed child care facility for each stipend award that is received
- Uphold all responsibilities as specified in T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood® agreement
