The nomination pool for this award includes private citizens who volunteer their time to the community or elected officials in Durham, Orange and Wake counties.

The criteria for selection of the individual include:

- Currently resides in Durham, Orange or Wake County
- Currently serves or has served any geographic area located in Durham, Orange or Wake County as an elected public official or community volunteer
- Demonstration of a commitment to improve the quality of early education
- Assuming a leadership role in improving early education in Durham, Orange or Wake County
- · Mobilization of others to action to accomplish goals for children and families
- Bringing about significant changes that improve the quality of life for families and young children
