Effective immediately, all T.E.A.C.H. scholarship eligibility income caps have been suspended through 6/30/2022. Individuals whose earnings exceeded the previous income cap are eligible to apply for the T.E.A.C.H. scholarship throughout the ECE workforce stabilization grant period.

This policy change will be revisited again for FY22-23.
